
Air pollution in Georgia: situation

- Ankara, Skopje, Tbilisi: the most polluted in Europe
- Almost 4 thousand premature deaths annually
- Pollution levels 3x higher than safe limits

in kilotons (millions of kg)




CZ: Air pollution protests



Success:


